



Call for Applications **Juárez Pérez Farmworker Summer Scholarship**

The Juárez Pérez Farmworker Summer Scholarship was created to honor David Juárez and Evangelina Pérez. David and Eva, themselves children of Braceros, migrated to California's San Joaquin Valley in the 1960's. They first started as migrant laborers, moving through the state until establishing a home in Hughson, California. The Juárez Pérez Family highly values education and aim to empower and support those children of farmworkers who are currently pursuing their own educational journeys. We seek to fund two undergraduate students who through scholarship or activism are working to better the lives of farmworkers in the United States.

Summer Awards:

- \$1,000 awarded directly to students in two installments (June and July 2019)
- \$200 family stipend for attending move-in day, orientation, graduation, or other important university event at any phase of the student's study

Eligibility:

- Undergraduate student (regardless of citizenship status) in an accredited community college or four-year university in the United States
- Demonstrate financial need
- Main source of income comes from farm-work or migrant labor (either the student's or family's)
- Service to farmworker communities

Application Materials:

- List of funding sources and amounts for summer 2019
- Proof of enrollment (e.g. class schedule, acceptance letter)
- Proof of financial need (e.g. FAFSA)
- Answer the following questions (max. 500 words each):

1. What motivated you to attend college?
2. What activities have you engaged in to help farmworker communities?
3. How do you intend to use your college degree to improve the lives of farmworking communities in the United States?
